"Guess Who's Coming to Dinner?" Richard Taittinger Gallery

Curated by art historian Ugochukwu-Smooth C. Nzewi, this look at contemporary art by artists who either call Africa home, or who work as part of the African diaspora is a welcome remedy to relative lack of exposure in New York for African art. The lineup includes 12 names who aren't well known outside of their respective communities.
