Celebrating the 70th anniversary of the legendary lab Pictorial Service, aka PICTO, this exhibition is a tribute to the historic relationship between Magnum Photos and Picto (which now has a New York presence) that started in the 1930s in Paris with the friendship between Magnum founders Henri Cartier-Bresson, Robert Capa, Chim (David Seymour) and George Rodger, and Picto's founder Pierre Gassmann. Curated by photography historian Carole Naggar, this show includes the work of 19 Magnum photographers — including Raymond Depardon, Antoine d'Agata, Josef Koudelka, Martine Franck, and Patrick Zachmann — and over 100 vintage and modern prints, bringing together Magnum's past and present generations.
